REACH- current situation of the products supplied by TURCO ESPAÑOLA, S.A.

Dear customer,

Please find below the current situation of TURCO ESPAÑOLA, S.A. with regard to Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH).

Our products are manufactured from mixtures of substances and/or preparations that we import or, for the most part, purchase from other suppliers in the European Union, therefore, we act as an intermediate user from the viewpoint of REACH. TURCO ESPAÑOLA, S.A. has implemented internal procedures in order to ensure that it does not use substances that do not comply with REACH.

Registration

The necessary steps have been taken to ensure that we use REACH compliant substances by checking with our suppliers on their registration status. The registration numbers of the substances can be found in the Safety Data Sheets (SDS) of our products (section 3).

Restriction (Appendix XVII)

The substance that is subject to restriction is listed in the Safety Data Sheet. Please note that although the restriction is cited, the products/applications are not necessarily affected.

Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC)

The European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) publishes the list of substances of very high concern (SVHC), which are candidates for inclusion in Appendix XIV (authorisation) of REACH. This list is updated regularly and can be consulted through the link <http://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table>.

Through the SDS, we inform you about the presence of SVHC substances ($\geq 0.1\%$ by weight) in the products we supply to you.

Authorisation (Appendix XIV)

The inclusion of a substance in Appendix XIV involves a series of actions, including the obligation to obtain an authorisation for use. The list of substances subject to authorisation is updated regularly and can be consulted on the ECHA website through the link <http://echa.europa.eu>.

TURCO ESPAÑOLA, S.A. takes the appropriate actions regarding authorisations and uses in order to ensure that our products comply with REACH. We will also keep you duly informed of any incident in the continuity of supply, as we cannot guarantee that the competent authorities will grant the requested authorisations.

Information on substances subject to authorisation will be communicated in Safety Data Sheets and on labels.

The Authorisation granted for a specific use will only apply to the applicants and all companies in their supply chain.

After the expiry date, no further use of the substance will be permitted unless authorisation has been granted to an actor upstream in the supply chain or an authorisation application has been made in the supply chain before the latest date and a decision by the competent authorities is still pending.

All companies in which the use of the substance is allowed under the Authorisation regime must comply with the conditions of the Authorisation specified by the European Commission. These conditions may include safety and environmental protection measures such as, but not limited to, engineering controls, personal protective equipment and emission and exposure control. The conditions can be found in the Chemical Safety Reports that are included in the Authorisation Application and are available on the ECHA website.

Safety Data Sheets (SDS) - Labelling - CLP Classification

All the products we place on the market have been classified according to the CLP classification, which is communicated in the SDS and labels. The format of the SDS is regulated in Article 31 and Appendix 2 of REACH.

The SDS are updated promptly as soon as significant changes are detected.

Extended Safety Data Sheets - Exposure Scenarios (ES)

For certain substances, REACH, depending on their hazardousness and the quantities handled, has established the need to develop Exposure Scenarios. Exposure Scenarios are intended to document the conditions of safe use of substances (operational conditions such as the duration of



use, concentrations and risk management measures, for example ventilation conditions, personal protective equipment).

When a product contains a single component for which its Exposure Scenarios are available, we provide them attached to the SDS: for multi-ingredient products, the risk management measures are communicated in the 16 sections of the Safety Data Sheet.

TURCO ESPAÑOLA, S.A. is aware of its obligations regarding REACH, therefore, we work with our suppliers to continue to ensure strict compliance with the regulation and to offer safety to our customers.
